



## General Volunteer Opportunities

The possibilities are endless! All committees and programs have tasks and blocks of time that need to be covered, and having volunteers that can slip in for a few hours helps round out the teams and get things done. The Coalition Executive Director handles the coordination of the general volunteers. All committee chairs/leads with tasks or projects will connect with the Executive Director who will in turn match up volunteers. However, it is also possible that the individual committees may know of and may independently recruit volunteers for their committee as needed. Below is a sampling of the types of tasks a general volunteer may be as to do:

- Run errands, such as dropping off/picking up printed materials at local print shops
- Scrapbook! – ongoing work with the Historian to document events
- AV – Help tape/take photos at a RCFY event
- File/sort/write/proofread
- Pick up donated supplies
- Help with set up at a RCFY sponsored event
- Create posters
- Make copies/put together information kits
- Bake! We need community members that are ready to turn the oven on!
- Chaperone a dance or youth action event
- Team up with the after school director to help with an activity
- Teach – the coalition is always on the hunt for local talent – do you have a skill or talent that you could share with the youth, through a hands-on demonstration or class?
- Present – Are you an expert in an area that would interest our youth and their parents? The board is constantly looking for individuals that are willing to give positive, thought provoking, youth focused -presentations around the topics that effect and interest our youth today.
