In North Iceland, you'll find the landscape has been formed by the sheer forces of nature. Run-offs caused by subglacial volcanic eruptions shaped Ásbyrgi canyon and Jökulsárgljúfur canyon, where the most powerful waterfall in Europe, Dettifoss, falls nearby. Glacial rivers that are now popular for whitewater rafting. Rock formations on the shores like Hvítserkur, waterfalls like Go afoss and canyons like Kolugljúfur will all make sure that visitors leave in awe, wondering how the next nature stop can possibly be more amazing than the last one.

The hallmark of North Iceland for walkers is its wide variety of trails. Just put on your hiking boots, and you'll find adventure! Sólheimajökull is an outlet glacier from the magnificent M rdalsjökull, and is surrounded by some of Iceland's most grand volcanoes. During summertime, a glacier lagoon forms in front of the glacier only adding to the charm of the location. This popular hiking destination is the perfect way to get in real contact with the true reason behind the name Ice-land! You will find blue ice, crevasses and amazing ice formations that will leave you in awe! This hike is suitable for all levels and does not require specific skills.



You'll also spend some time on the ocean during a three-hour whale watching boat tour with a professional crew experienced in finding and observing Icelandic wildlife! Getting this close to the majestic whales is an absolutely magical experience. Watching whales has become one of the most common activities among foreign visitors to North Iceland. In fact, Húsavík and Eyjafjörur were among the first places in the country as a whole that offered whale-watching excursions. The number of species, along with favorable weather and sea conditions, make North Iceland one of the best Icelandic areas for spotting whales. The experience becomes complete by seeing dolphins and minke, humpback or even blue whales play beside one of the particularly appealing oakwood boats used exclusively in North Iceland.
