What is a coalition?


A coalition is a formal arrangement for cooperation and collaboration between groups or sectors of the community,

in which each group retains its identity but all agree to work together towards


a common goal of building a safe and healthy community.

The data received helps us monitor progress and identify new priorities.

What information is helpful to know regarding substance misuse?

- Age of onset
- Perception of Harm
- Perception of Wrongness (self, peers, parents)
- Age of first use
- Lifetime use
- Past 30 days







Past 30 Days Middle School










Bullying - Middle School











12% of students **rode** in a car or vehicle with someone who had been drinking **alcohol**

3% of students **drove** in a car or vehicle while drinking **alcohol.**

21% of students **rode** in a car or vehicle with someone who had been using **marijuana**.

8% of students **drove** in a car or vehicle while they had used **marijuana**.


41% Of students had at least one parent who talked with them about the dangers of tobacco, alcohol, or drug use during the past 12 months.
