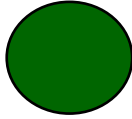

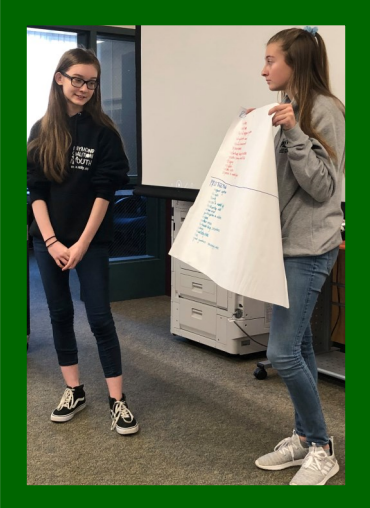

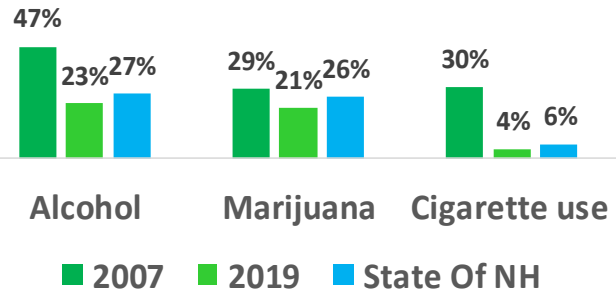
RCFY was formed in 2000 in response to Raymond students reporting higher rates of substance misuse than the State of NH average. We are happy to report that our 2019 data reflects the lowest rates of substance misuse since that time and that we are now lower than the State in our most concerning areas.

RCFY is committed to promoting safe, healthy, drug-free choices for our youth and community. Investing in RCFY helps us to engage, empower, and educate youth and volunteers so we can continue our work.

2020 was a particularly hard year for nonprofits and we are looking forward to being back out in the community offering fun, interactive events and programs, including our Gala set for March 6th, to financially support RCFY.

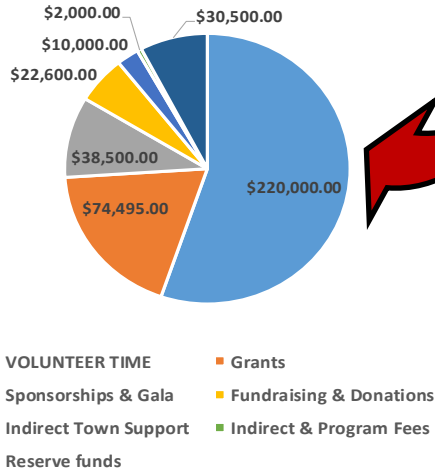

**2021 RCFY Proposed Revenue and Resources**



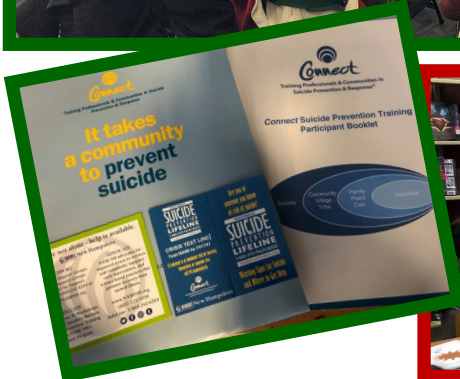

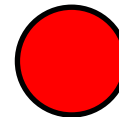
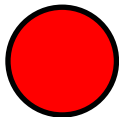
**Celebrate 2020 with us!!**
